



Dear Valued YMCA Member,

I am following up with you as we receive additional questions about our plans amid the COVID-19 crisis and in light of recent notices, alerts, and directives from state and local leaders.

- **Due to orders issued today by Ohio Governor Mike Dewine, the Champaign Family YMCA will close our fitness center, gym, pool, and lobby at 9:30 pm today, Monday, March 16, and will remain closed until further notice.**
- Our previously scheduled Schools Day Out program will proceed during the week of March 16 unless mandated otherwise. We will do our very best to socially distance the youth and will continue the extensive cleaning and disinfecting procedures the Y has adopted in response to the current pandemic.
- Our state licensed, 5-star childcare program will remain open as long as we are able to maintain appropriate staff to child ratios. The program could be suspended with short notice should a Champaign County resident test positive for Covid-19 or via mandate from the governor's office. Parents are urged to have alternate plans for care.
- For a limited time, members will have access to YMCA 360: Your Virtual YMCA online workout channel at no charge. Search for YMCA 360 on YouTube to access these classes from the comfort of your own home.

Our Y is reaching out to health care and other essential sectors of our local workforce to see how we can help during this challenging time. We hope that you will choose to remain a Y member until this pandemic has passed.
