



# SUMMER DAY CAMPS

## CAMP SHIFFER

Our Camp Shiffer location is a geologically diverse property that campers will explore. Camp Shiffer features include wetlands fed by artesian wells, hiking trails throughout 80-acres that are shaded by mature woods, a small creek, a solar-powered camp shelter with restrooms, and a large meadow. Campers spend time hiking, practicing archery, enjoying play features (a horizontal climbing wall, GaGa pit, tetherball, and basic sports), learning how to cook on a campfire, and seeing diverse trees, plants, and wildlife.
