Please read the following information carefully and be aware that in registering yourself or your minor child/ward for participation in the city pool program(s), you will be waiving and releasing all claims for injuries you or your child/ward might sustain arising out of the program(s). I give permission for my child/ward/self to participate in this program, trip, or activity and hereby waive, release and forever discharge any and all claims against the Urbana City Pool, Champaign Family YMCA, their commissioners, employees, and volunteers for damages and/or injuries to the registrant, which may arise from participation in Urbana City Pool programs.

Coronavirus / COVID-19 Waiver: Coronavirus, COVID-19 is an extremely contagious virus that spreads easily through person-to-person contact. Federal and state authorities recommend social distancing as a means to prevent the spread of the virus. COVID-19 can lead to severe illness, personal injury, permanent disability, and death. Participating in Urbana City Pool programs or accessing Urbana City Pool facilities could increase the risk of contracting COVID-19. Urbana City Pool/Champaign Family YMCA in no way warrant that COVID-19 infection will not occur through participation in Urbana City Pool programs or accessing Urbana City Pool facilities.

 Waiver required! For insurance purposes, Urbana City Pool or Champaign Family YMCA programs and activities require a signed waiver. Patrons, member or non, WILL NOT be able to participate in classes or programs if the waiver is not signed.



Urbana Municipal Pool Rules and Regulations



- Season passes are not transferable and may only be used by the person whose name appears on the pass. Passes will be revoked, without a refund, if there is misuse. There will be a \$5.00 replacement charge, per pass, if it is lost or stolen.
- Family passes can include parents and their children under the age of 18. Children 18 through 23 are only included on season passes if they are a full-time student. Proof of student status must be provided. Family passes do not include grandparents, nannies, baby sitters, cousins, nieces, nephews, grandchildren, or out of town guests. Nurses and/or medical caregivers are permitted to be placed on a family pass if documentation is provided stating the medical condition.
- All youth under eight (8) years of age are to be directly supervised by an adult or babysitter fifteen (15) years of age or older. Youth age eight (8) and older can be at the pool without the direct supervision of an adult or babysitter but must know the location and be able to contact that person in the event of an emergency. Youth ages eight (8) and older should not be at the pool unsupervised for more than 4 hours at a time.
- Youth will be required to pass a swim test before entering the deep end of the pool.
- Appropriate swimwear is required for swimming; street clothes, such as cut-offs, gym shorts, or leggings, are not allowed in the pool. Thong-style or other revealing swimwear are prohibited.
- All floatation devices must be Coast Guard approved.

Urbana City Pool Weather Guidelines

- When lightning or thunder is seen or heard, the pool will be cleared for 30 minutes. After each recurrence of thunder or lightning, the 30-minute rest period will restart. If thunderstorms are persistent, the pool manager will close the pool. If the pool is closed for weather before 3 pm, the pool manager will re-evaluate at 3:30 pm and determine if it is safe to re-open.
- If the air temperature drops below 65 degrees and the skies are overcast and/or raining, the pool office will open for information and membership sales only from 12:00 p.m. - 2:00 pm. The weather will be re-evaluated at 2:00 pm and the guidelines for thunderstorms (as listed above) will be followed.

COVID-19 Related Rules and Regulations

- For the 2020 operating season, the maximum number of people allowed in the pool facility at one time is 250. The maximum number of individuals allowed in the main pool at one time is 100. The maximum number of individuals allowed in the baby pool at one time is 10. Patrons may check capacity before coming to the pool by visiting the Champaign Family YMCA website.
- No swimming or gathering in groups of more than 10. Do not gather in groups of different households.
- Swimmers and individuals on the pool's grounds are expected to use social distancing and maintain at least 6 feet between individuals of different households.
- It is recommended that all patrons wear face masks whenever social distancing cannot be maintained (entering and exiting the facility, restrooms, concession area, etc.).
- Deck chairs will be spaced to ensure appropriate safe distancing; no moving of City-provided deck chairs is allowed. City-provided chairs will be cleaned by pool staff between users. Patrons are encouraged to bring their own chairs and observe 6-foot spacing.
- Men's and Women's locker rooms will be open.

Daily Admission Policies

- Daily admission patrons will be required to complete a guest card prior to their first visit to the pool. For youth age seventeen (17) or younger, an adult parent or guardian must complete a guest card on behalf of the child. This need only be completed once each season.
